Event Rules

The Stewards of the Sierra National Forest would like to take a moment and say Thank You for registering for our event. As you may be aware the rules, regulations and insurance industry requirements put forth by the AMA have dramatically changed from previous years' events.

To get our event insured through the AMA please take a moment and read the insurance mandated event rules below that we must adhere to, for the Stewards to receive AMA sanctioned insurance.

1. All riders must have currently registered, street-legal motorcycle with all required road-going equipment (e.g. lights, turn signals, horn, etc.) in addition to a USDA Approved spark arrestor.
2. All riders must wear a DOT approved helmet while riding.
3. All riders must have a current driver's license with motorcycle endorsement.
4. All riders must have current and valid motorcycle insurance that meets minimum requirements for the state where registered.
5. No outside alcohol is allowed to be brought into the Oakhurst Community Center.
6. All riders must ride in pairs or groups.
7. All riders must check in and attend the riders meeting at 8:00 am at the beginning of each riding day at the Oakhurst Community Center.
8. No alcohol may be consumed before or during the riding portion of the event. NO DRINKING AND RIDING.
9. No reckless riding or stunt riding is allowed during the event. Obey all traffic laws.
10. All riders must stay on the approved routes. No deviations from the approved routes.
11. All riders must check out from the days ride with event staff at end of the day at the Oakhurst Community Center.
